REVISED SELECTION PROCEDURE & MTS FOR SELECTION OF TEAM

FOR 2ND WDSC, HANOVER 2024.

As notified earlier, the selection of team for 2nd World Deaf Shooting Championship will be done on the basis of average of 2 best scores out of 3 scores. The 3 scores being the score of 22nd Kumar Surendra Singh Shooting Championship & double trials to be tentatively held in July.


Shooters who achieved Trial MQS in 66th NSCC or 22nd KSS Championship per Annexure 'A' will only be eligible to participate in the double trial.


As per revised selection procedure shooters have to achieve the Minimum Travel Score (MTS) also mentioned in Annexure 'A' at least once in the 3 scores to be eligible for selection.

In events where there are 3 or less number of eligible participants, out of which some achieve the MTS in the 22nd KSS, those shooters need not participate in the double trials. Shooters who did not achieve MTS in 22nd KSS Championship may participate in the double trials to achieve the same. (only in events with 3 or less participants)

Shooters achieving the MTS will be ranked according to their average of best two scores and top 3 ranked shooters will be eligible for selection subject to approval and sanction from SAI regarding number of shooters to be selected.
